Asger Jorn & Per Kirkeby: Two Influential Innovators of Scandinavian Art

In this online lecture, delivered in English, Lucas Haberkorn from Museum Jorn compares the two artists Asger Jorn (1914–1973) and Per Kirkeby (1938–2018), who are among the most important Danish figures in recent European art history. Museum Jorn in Silkeborg, Denmark, administrates an important part of the artistic legacy of both painters in their collections.
